#### <u>Maths</u>

Reception children will be doing maths daily. The children will begin counting to a range of objects up to 6 and then progressing onto 'Match, Sort and Compare' unit learning to compare objects by size, shape and pattern. The children will end the term talking about measure and patterns of shape.

# **English**

The class will use Write Stuff to investigate the book 'Grandad's Island' looking at sentences and how stories are put together. The children will be concentrating on recognising and writing their name, and writing initial sounds for pictures. The children will use their imagination to create stories using role play and small world. As they learn their first set I sounds they will start to orally blend and segment words and start reading simple CVC words.

#### Phonics

The children will begin learning their set I sounds daily following the scheme Read Write Inc. There will be a Phonics workshop for parents to attend.

## PSHE - Being me in my world

Covers a wide range of topics including a sense of belonging, welcoming others and being part of a school community.



### PE

Our PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday. The children will be in the hall and outside working on coordination, teamwork, resilience and sportsman ship in PE. Please ensure that your child has a full PE kit in school every day of the school week.

### RE

In RE the children will be looking at Creation. The children will be making links to 'Who are we?'

# Art and DT

The children this half term will be drawing self portraits of themselves and looking at colour mixing.

#### Topic- Understanding the world What Makes Me Me?
