

Maths

In Maths the Year 1 children will be altogether in Chestnut learning about Place Value to 10. The children will be using number lines, matching and comparing numbers to 10 so they have a solid knowledge of place value within 10 before moving onto addition and subtraction within 10.



English

The class will use Write Stuff to investigate the book 'Grandad's Island'. The children will be improving their sentences by using capital letters and full stops. The children will learn to use connectives in their sentences like 'but' and understand what prepositions are. The children will continue using their phonics in their writing. The children will write an independent emotive story at the end of the unit.

Phonics

The children will continue learning their phonics sounds and having guided reading within their phonics lessons. The children will begin learning cursive handwriting.

PSHE - Being me in my world

Covers a wide range of topics including a sense of belonging, welcoming others and being part of a school community.



PE

Our PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday. The children will be in the hall and outside working on coordination, teamwork, resilience and sportsmanship in PE.

RE

In RE the children will be looking at Creation. The children will be making links to 'Who are we?'

Term 1 Autumn 1

Art and DT

The children this half term will be learning about 'Colour', exploring primary and secondary colours.
